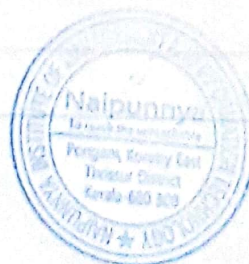


Report
