



### Department of Languages


- Upgrading the Department to a PG department.

### Department of Hotel Management


- To identify student mobility schemes that offer opportunities for students, such as study abroad, work experience or experiential opportunities.
- To identify hotels who would provide weekend training to advanced learners to facilitate employability.
- To deliver intensive in-house training to advanced learners so that more students get employment as management trainees in hotels of global repute.
- To conduct tutorial classes after class for below average students in core papers.
- To facilitate at least 2 faculty members in the department to register for Ph.D. in core papers.
- To facilitate research paper presentation and publication for every faculty member.
- To increase linkage with Hotel Management Institutes to support faculty exchange programmes.
- To implement 3 days compulsory faculty exposure in hotel industry or premium Hotel Management Institutes in an academic year
- To implement Food Safety training and examination for students of second year for 30 hours.
- To conduct workshops on carving, fish fillet, Fire safety and wine by recognized institutions in the second year.
- Renovate advanced training restaurant, Pantry and Storage.

#### Long Term

- To increase the diversity of our student body by seeking to attract students from other states.
- Recruit and retain highly trained and qualified faculty and staff.
- Improve infrastructure to maintain state-of-the-art technology and equipment.
- Achieve accreditation from the American Culinary Federation (ACF) and the Accrediting Commission for Programs in Hospitality.
- Develop appropriate national/international student learning experiences.
- Expand existing campus facilities to include additional classrooms and kitchen laboratories.
- To construct a suite room laboratory for accommodation operation practical.



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- To construct a Bakery lab, recommended by the university inspection body which can accommodate 36 students.
  - Develop a retail/foodservice facility for serving the public.
  - To interact with the university for a separate Board of studies and enhance the syllabus to international standards
  - To start with PG programmes under university of Calicut.
  - To increase the collaborations and MOUs with industry and culinary institutions.
  - To initiate AICTE and WACS accreditations to reach international standards of skill training.
  - Ensure that 2% of faculty strength in a year secure AHLEI trainers certificate.


### **PG Department of Commerce**

- Technical Journal - Annual Publication


