Kerala is again hit by another flood this year. While the state has been recovering from the 2018 flood, another deluge devastated Kerala. The August flood of 2019 has severely affected and taken away many lives. The people had to leave everything behind them, just to move to safety. Lakhs of people had to move to relief camps for their survival. It was certainly not an easy situation for them. Help needed to reach them on an urgent basis.

The Students Union and SWAS Club immediately formed a team for the relief work and named the programme as "REBUILD MISSION 2.0" which means "reconstruct" or "recreate". The student Volunteers collected flood relief materials from all students. A campaign including fund raising and Dress material collection from students was carried out from 16th August to 22nd August 2019. The message to cut down the celebrations and donate the same to the relief fund was well observed. The team was able to pool Rs. 81213/- from the student community. A sum of Rs. 149,764/- was also collected from the teaching and the non-teaching staff members.

Students were excited at the opportunity to volunteer themselves for the flood affected people. Volunteers purchased the needy products including biscuits, clothes, bed sheets, grocery items and all other products which are requested. A total of 17 student volunteers participated in the flood rehabilitation program in Agali and sholayar panchayath in Palakkad District from August 21st 2019 to August 24th 2019. Attappadi was severely hit by landslides and the condition was intricate. The team could see tens of electric post's broken down and damaged roads. Due to climatic issues and the damaged roads, it was difficult to reach to several camps and affected areas. The team also interact with the affected people of Attappadi from whom the volunteers came to know about the catastrophic lifestyle of the people.

Principal Fr. (Dr) Paulachan.K.J, Fr. (Dr) Varghese Pulickal, Mr. Jiss Jose, Assistant professor NIMIT, Ms. Anjali Thomas, Assistant professor NIMIT, coordinated the activities in Attappadi. A total of 17 student volunteers from our college successfully completed cleaning of 3 houses and 1 community hall before 24th of August 2019. The team also distributed 25 kits containing food supplies, clothes, house hold items and sleeping mats. The cleaned houses includes 2 from Agali panchayath and a house from Sholayar panchayath of Attappadi.
