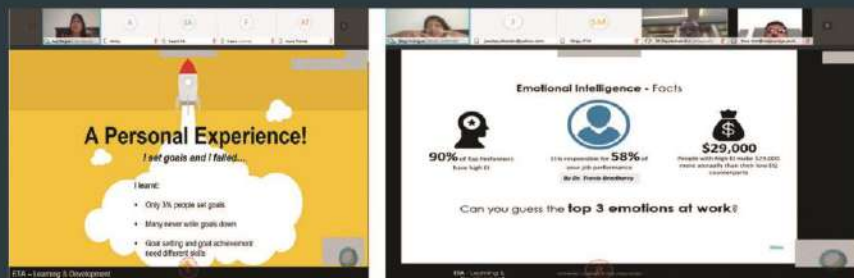


## Naipunnya College Newsletter

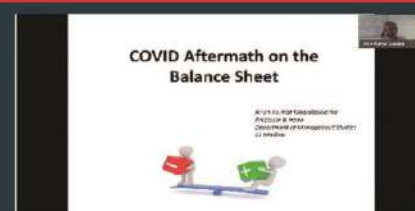


**SPLASH**

**BE ONLINE, BE SMART**

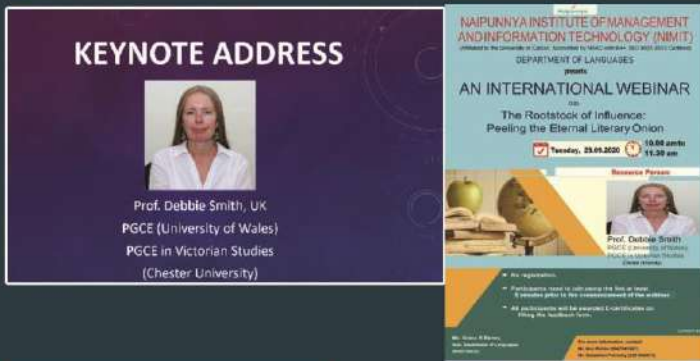

### CORSA 2020



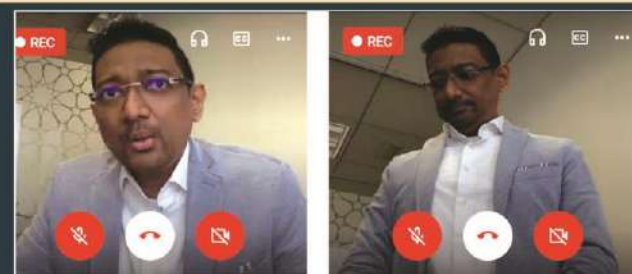

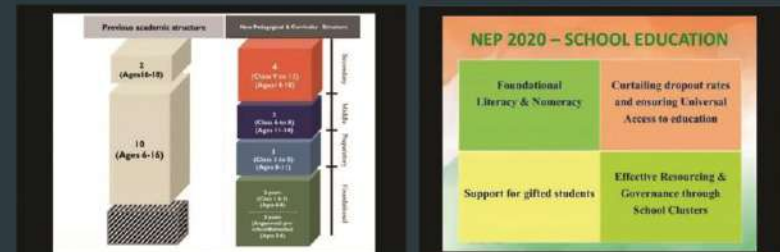


**NATIONAL ONLINE TRAINING**
