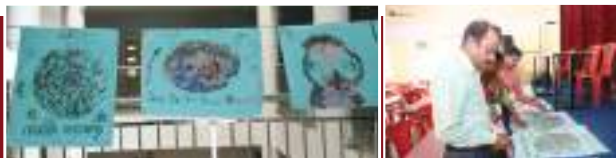
COLLEGE UNION ELECTION

This was an event conducted on 29th and 30th October by II BCom Finance A batch in order to find the best management team.



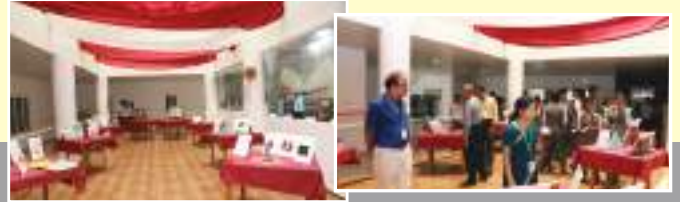
RESEARCH FORUM
