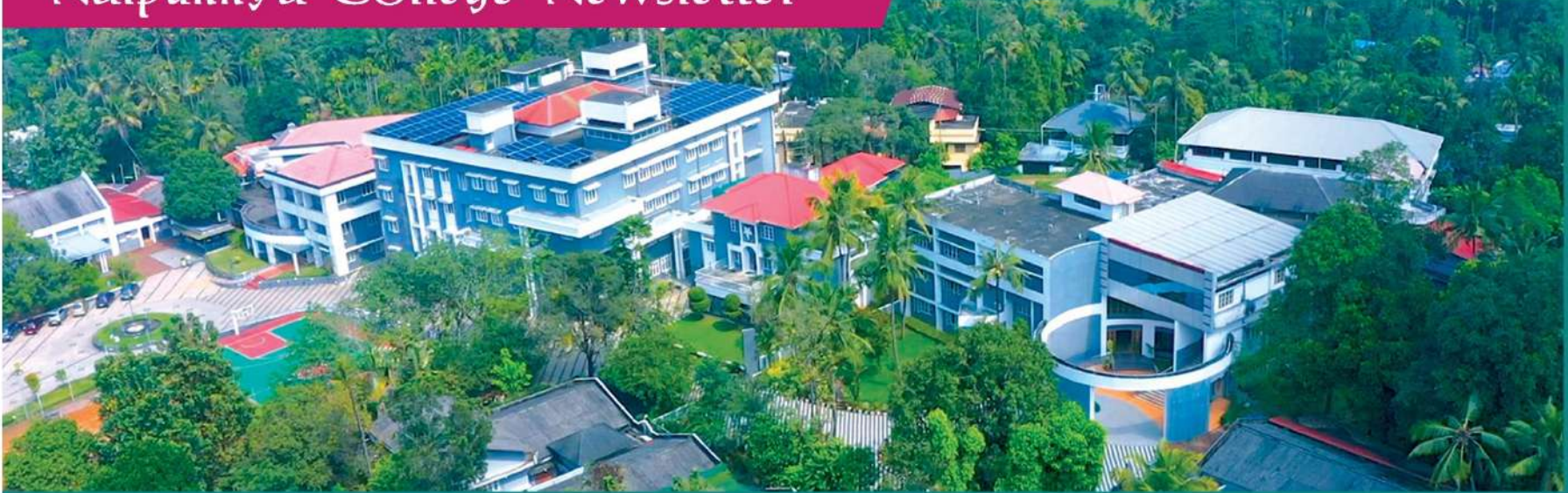

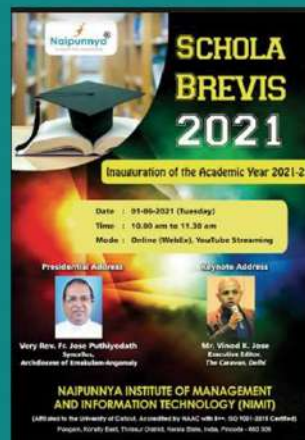
Faculty Rejuvenation Programme

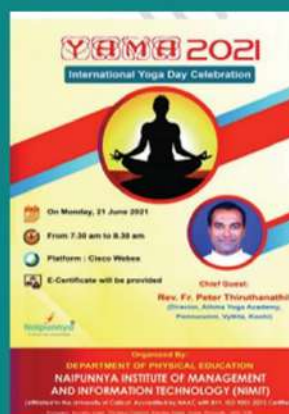
Environment Day

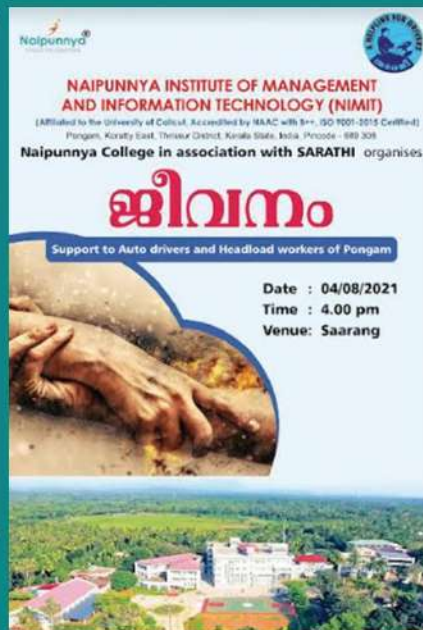
National Doctor's Day

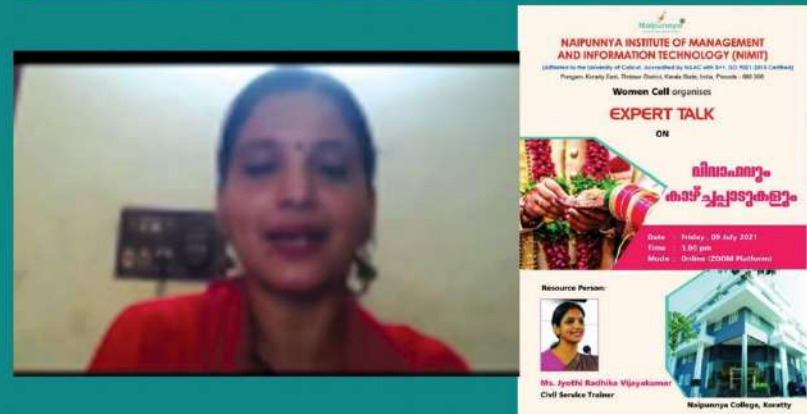
IT Club Inauguration

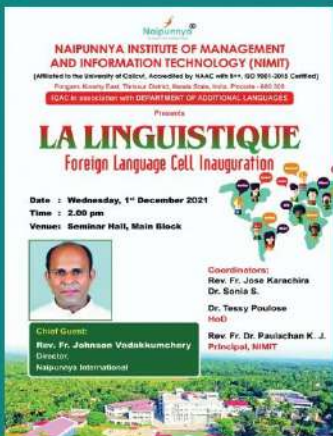
Nexus - Freshers' Orientation Programme

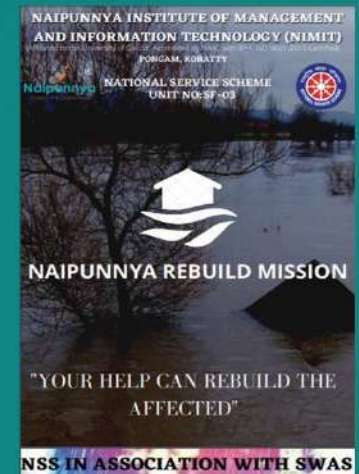


Kerala Piravi
