International Day of Disabled Persons


"There is no greater disability in society, than the inability to see a person as more" -Robert M. Hensel

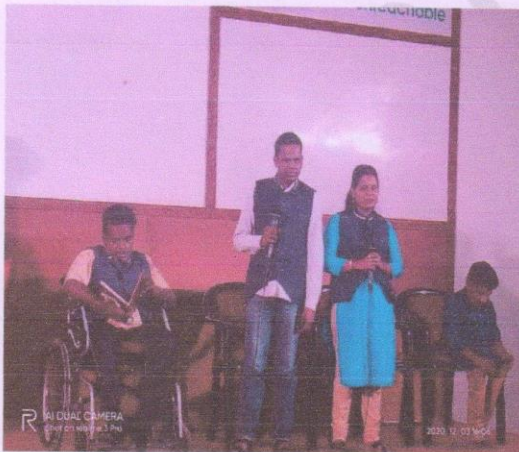

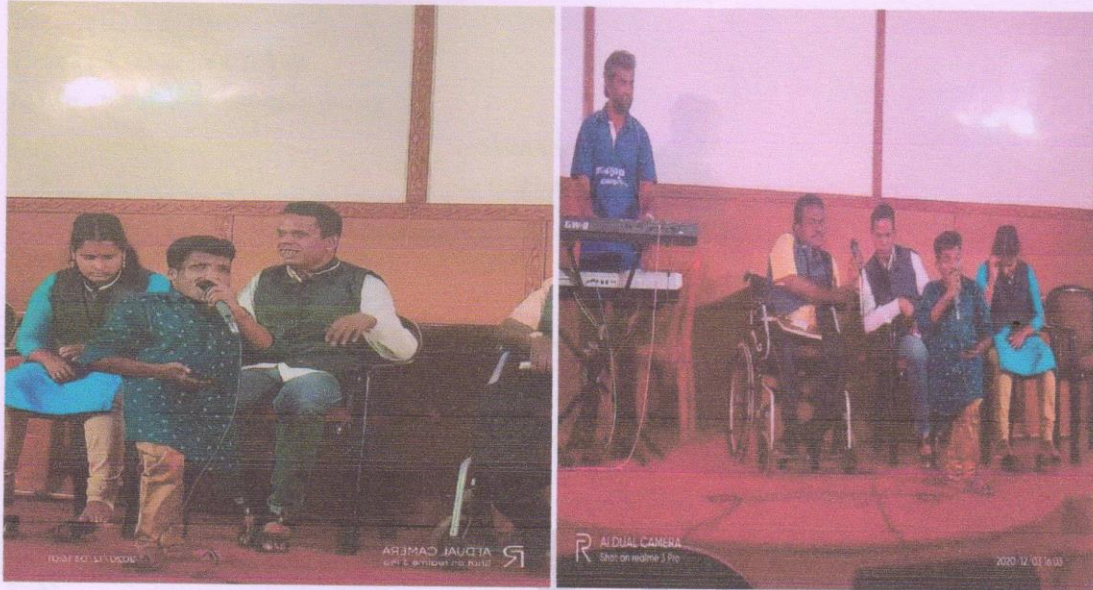
