

Report of Student satisfaction Survey 2019-20

Survey was conducted by randomly choosing 98 students equally from each class. responses were collected using a google form. Form consists of 20 multiple choice 5 scale questions with choices strongly agree , agree , neutral , disagree and strongly agree and a short answer question “Give three observation / suggestions to improve the overall teaching – learning experience in your institution.” Aggregate score is calculated for each question as displayed below and a cumulative score is also calculated which is **8.01/10**.

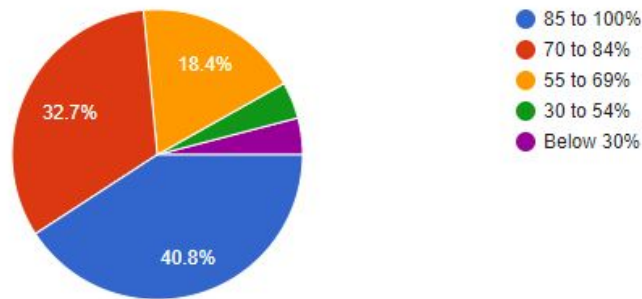

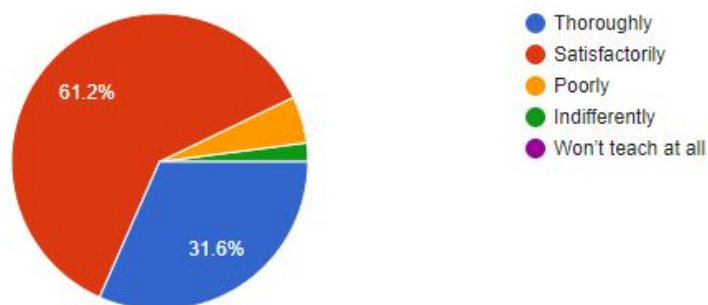
How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

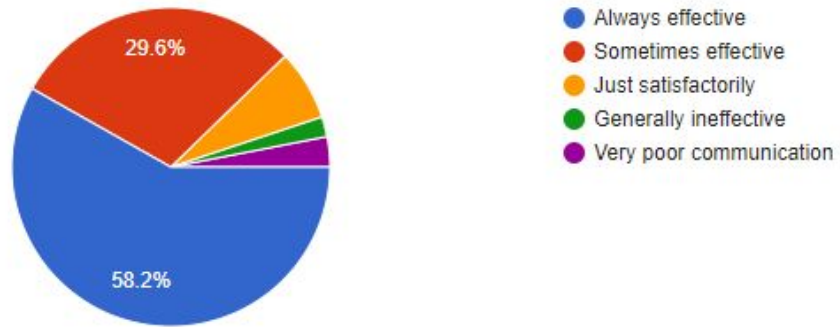
How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

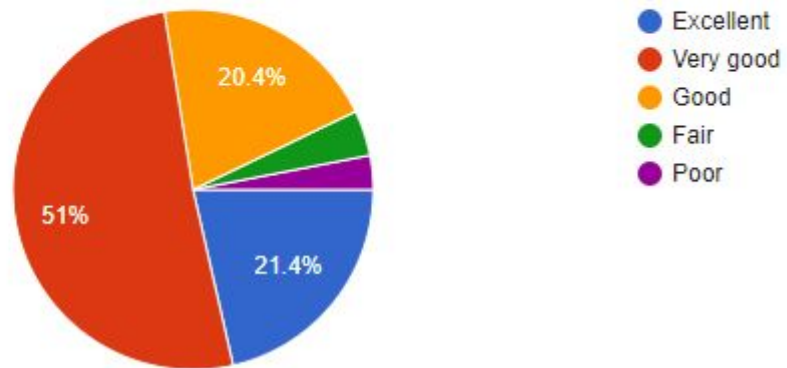
How well were the teachers able to communicate?

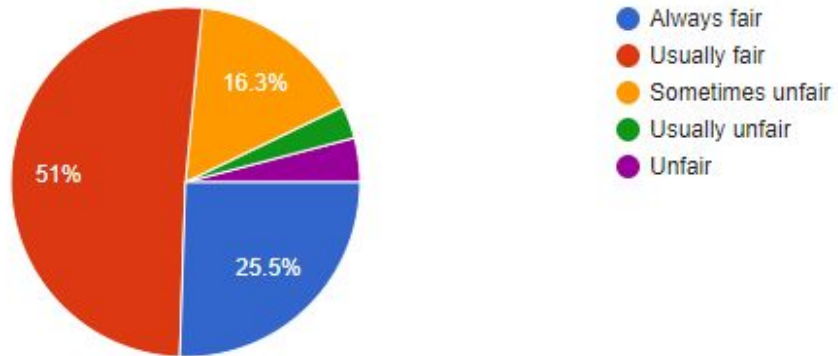
The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

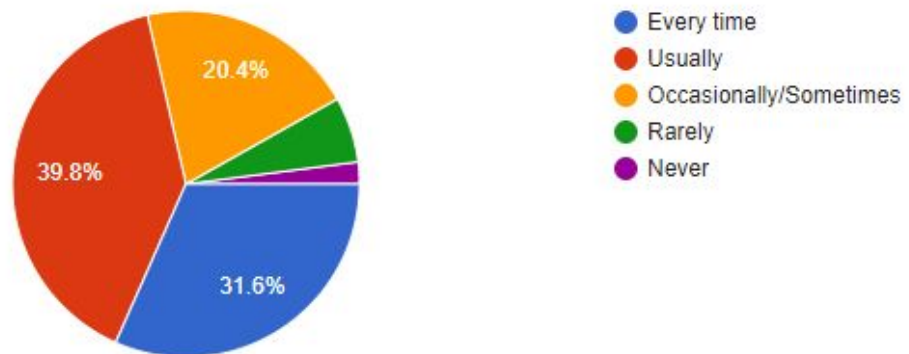

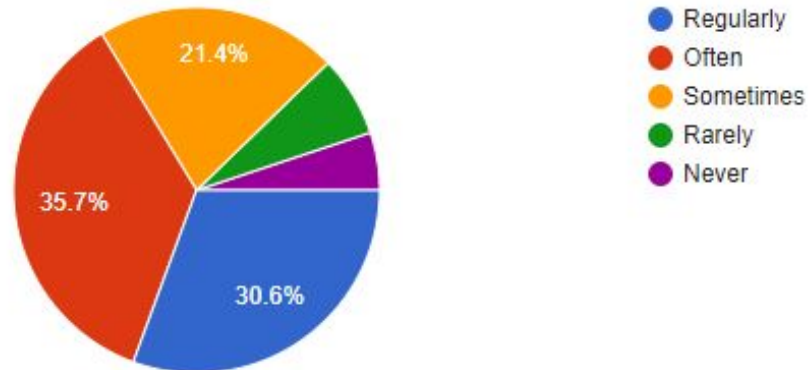

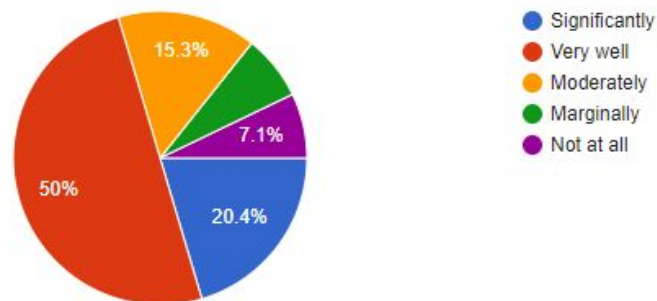

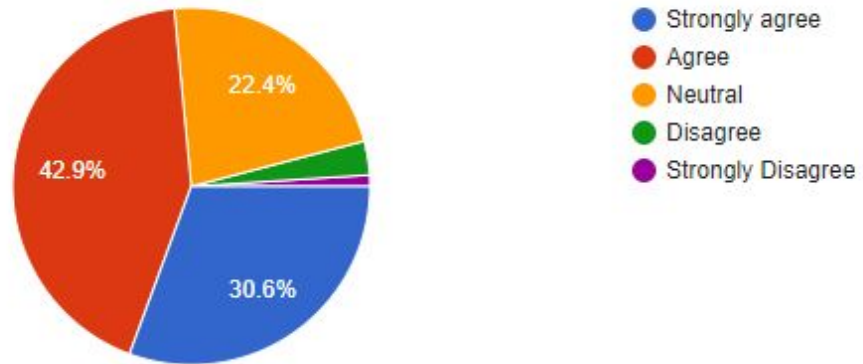

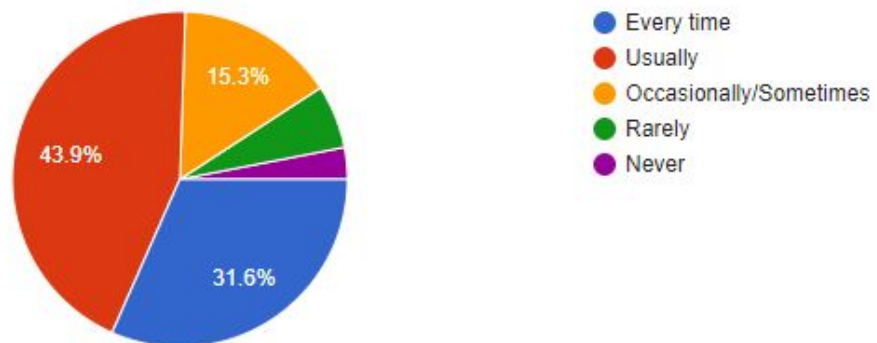

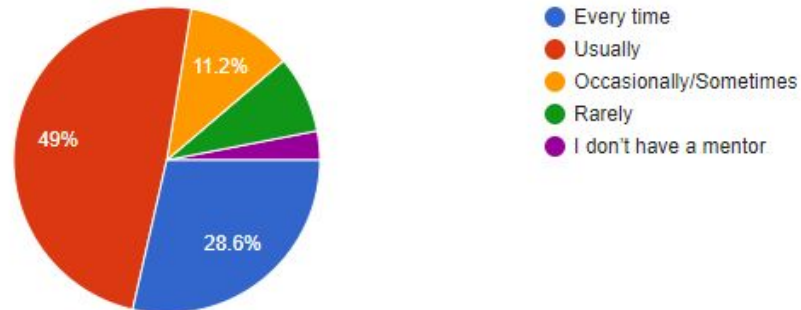

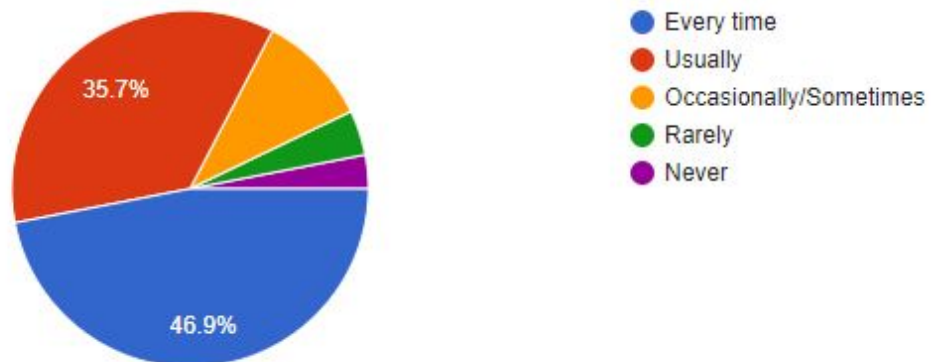

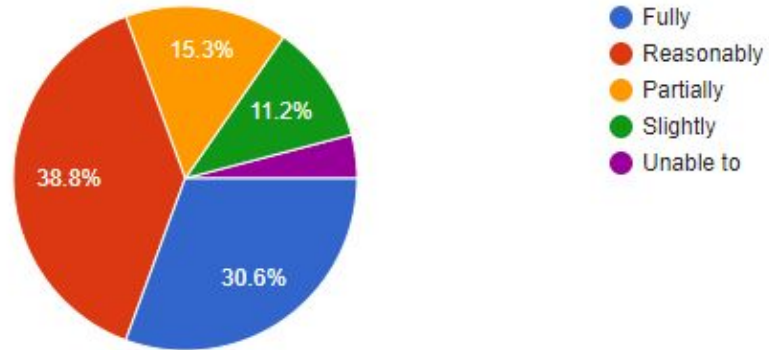

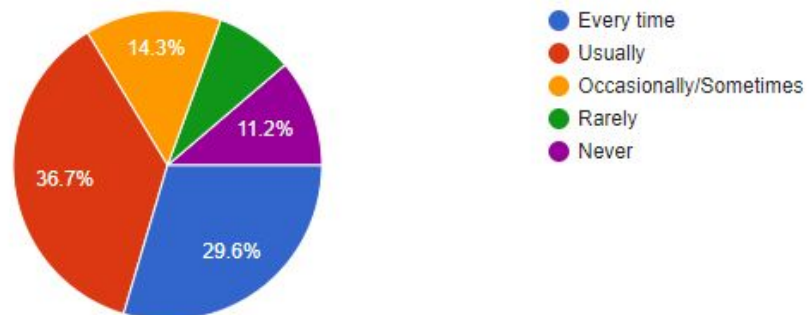

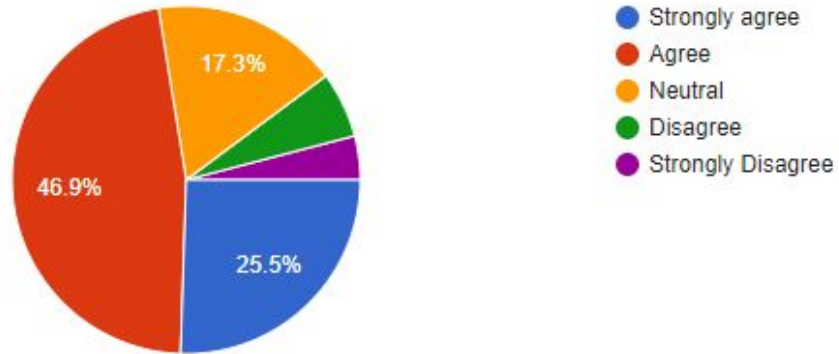

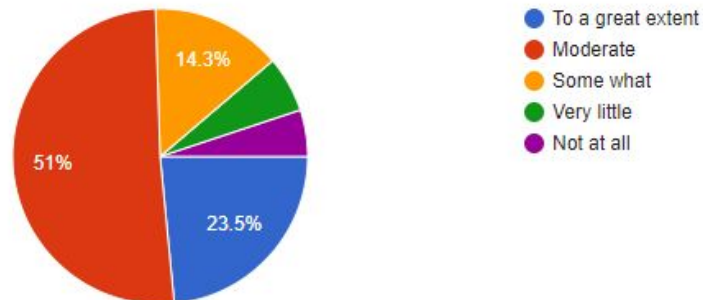
