Annual Report 2020-21

During the year 2020-21, SWAS has initiated many common events apart from class wise social service activities. The activities have taken amongst the students, faculties and non-teaching staffs in the college. During the pandemic situation of COVID 19, SWAS conducted more than 10 Lockdown Outreach Activities during April-June.

Initiatives taken by Naipunnya Institute of Management and Information Technology, Pongam during national lockdown arising out of the COVID-19 outbreak are below.

1. Given Naipunnya Men's hostel for quarantine purpose
2. Corpus fund- The college had raised a corpus fund by accepting financial contributions from the teaching fraternity to support the student community, during these hard times. The total contribution from teachers were Rs. 68250/- as on 22nd May 2020. The class teachers have shared the names of students needing financial assistance.
3. Given an amount of Rs. 10000/- to Koratty Panchayat for community kitchen.
4. Distributed 70 chicken biriyani to Koratty Police station.
5. As part of Covid-19 services, spent Rs. 15000/- for repairing Koratty Police station vehicle.
6. Given snacks and groceries to Anandabhavan, Mangalassery.
7. Provided grocery items to one of our student's family in Karukutty.
8. Given 50 Kg Rice, 20 chairs, 5 tables and 5 table sheets to Koratty Grama Panchayath.
9. Share the gift of knowledge- Distributed Note books and text books for needy students.
10. Purchased masks and sanitizers for staffs.
11. Placed sanitizers and handwash in the campus.
12. Conducted quiz competitions.
13. Conducted international and national level webinars by different departments.
14. Online classes conducted through Linways AMS.
15. Conducted online quiz for the faculty.
16. Conducted a survey on mental well-being during the period of COVID 19.
17. Tele / Online counselling.
18. Distributed disinfectants to Koratty panchayat.

19. Creation of a video of 10 minutes duration about "How did NIMITians spend Corona lock down period" to upload in our website and YouTube channel. For that we have invited small/ raw video clips of 10 seconds to 1 minute length which shows any activities of the lock down period. We have circulated the message to our students group to assure maximum participation. Best videos have compiled/edited for the final presentation.
20. Share the Gift of knowledge- As part of the student assistance programme during COVID-19, our institution has helped 34 students of our college by distributing their required number of notebooks. The programme has conducted on 23/06/2020.
21. 'ഒരുമിച്ചു ഒരോണം' -Lending a hand to the needy - During Onam days it was noted that some of our students were really struggling to meet their daily lives. When our students were going through such difficulties, it was our responsibility to spread the festive cheer among the needy by providing some financial assistance. In that situation, SWAS initiated an outreach programme 'ഒരുമിച്ചു ഒരോണം' - Lending a hand to the needy for the third year students. As part of the programme, both the classes and the institution have provided the contribution and we were able to provide a contribution of Rs.3500/- each to 10 needy students of our college on 28/08/2020.
22. Nettoyage (Gandhi Jayanthi Celebration) - As part of Gandhi Jayanthi, SWAS club of NIMIT in association with Sahrudaya Welfare has initiated "NETTOYAGE" - Video making competition for students of NIMIT. The programme conducted on 2/10/2020. Attractive cash prizes have given for the winners on 3rd December 2020 during the programme PROWESS.
23. Rebuild Mission- As the continuation of Rebuild Mission (Flood Relief Program) which Naipunnya have taken up in the month of August 2019 at Attappadi, Naipunnya College has constructed a house for a flood hit victim and the blessing of new house happened on 3rd October at 11:00 am in Attappadi. The entire college all together including staffs and students equally contributed for rendering a helping hand for the needy.
24. PROWESS 2020 was a special occasion for Naipunnya to celebrate the skills and expertise of our differently abled students. On 3/12/2020 differently abled students of our college has presented various entertainment programmes. We have also enjoyed the musical performance by Sahrudaya Melodies.


