Activities and Initiatives:

- **ZERO HUNGER**

'Zero Hunger' was launched by SWAS during the academic year 2018-2019. As part of World Food Day, during the academic year 2018-19, SWAS hosted competitions such as poster making and collage with the theme 'Zero Hunger' on 16/10/2018. After the competition, SWAS coordinators displayed all the posters and collages made by the participants as an exhibition. SWAS arranged trophies and certificates for the winners as appreciation and distributed them during the assembly.

The 'Zero Hunger' initiative put under the Hand in Hand project during the year 2023-24. The primary aim of this endeavor is to eradicate hunger among the students of NIMIT. It strives to ensure that every student within the campus has access to adequate, safe, and nutritious food, thereby addressing the issue of food insecurity among students. The overarching goal is to ensure that no student attends college on an empty stomach.

A daily provision of lunch packs has been established to cater to students facing hunger at NIMIT. Recognizing the importance of addressing immediate food needs, this initiative ensures that no student goes without a meal during their time on campus. Each day, a dedicated team from the department of Hotel Management prepares nutritious and balanced lunch packs to meet the dietary requirements of the students. The ingredients are sourced from the campus for the sustainability. Following the preparation, the lunch packs are promptly distributed to students identified as in need. This distribution process is conducted discreetly and with sensitivity to ensure the dignity and privacy of the recipients.

Through this initiative, the Hand in Hand project aims to continue upholding its mission of ensuring the holistic well-being and success of every member of the campus community.

• **SPARK'23 Basketball Tournament:**

As part of the Hand in Hand project, the "SPARK'23 Rev. Fr. Jose Karachira Memorial National Level Men Basketball Tournament - 2023-24" was organized by Naipunnya College, Koratty on December 21st and 22nd, 2023. This tournament witnessed the participation of 8 colleges from across India. The team from Sahrdaya College, Kodakara emerged victorious, securing the first position, while the Cochin University team claimed the second position. Additionally, Sathyabhama University, Chennai, and KE College, Mannanam-Kottayam shared the third position in the championship. The prizes were distributed by Rev. Fr. Jimmy Kunnathoor, the Assistant Executive Director of NIMIT.






