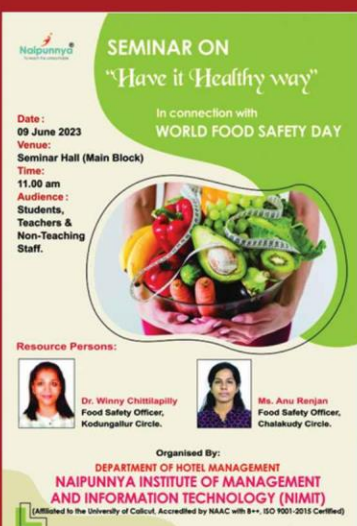
Faculty Rejuvenation Program 2023

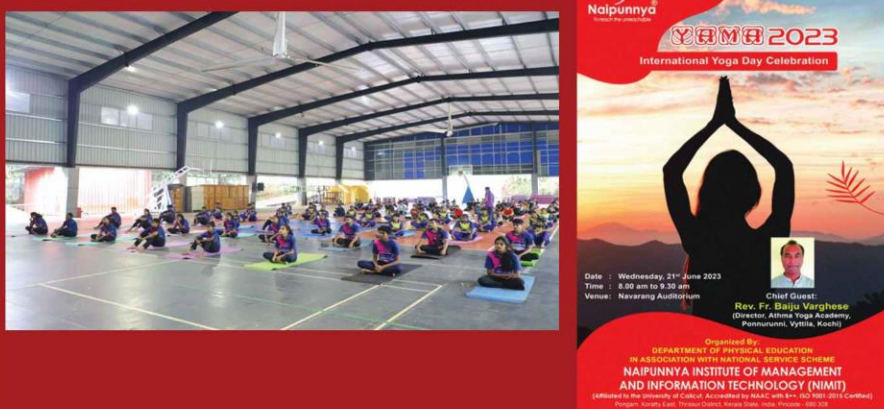
Reading Day Week 2023

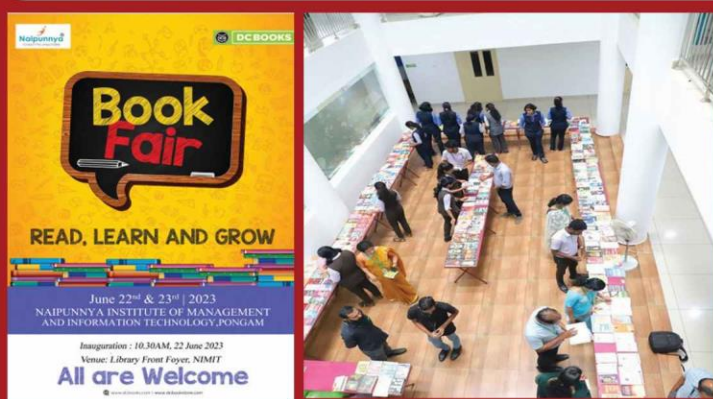
Yoga Day

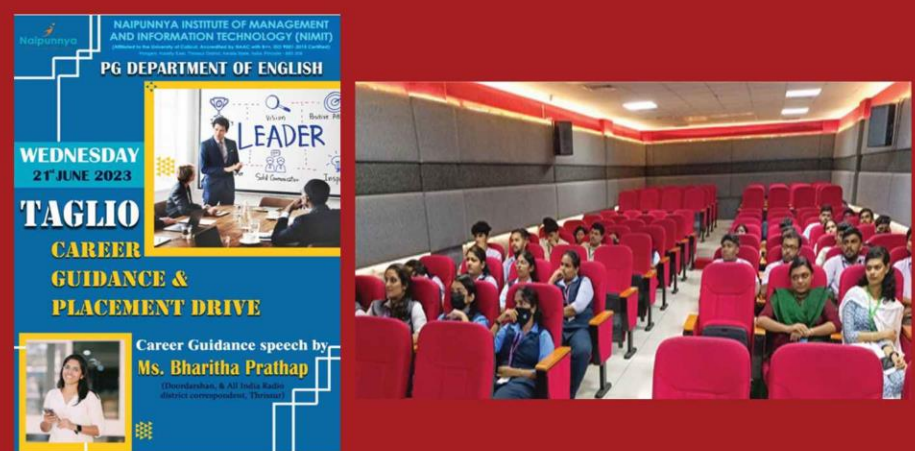
World Music Day

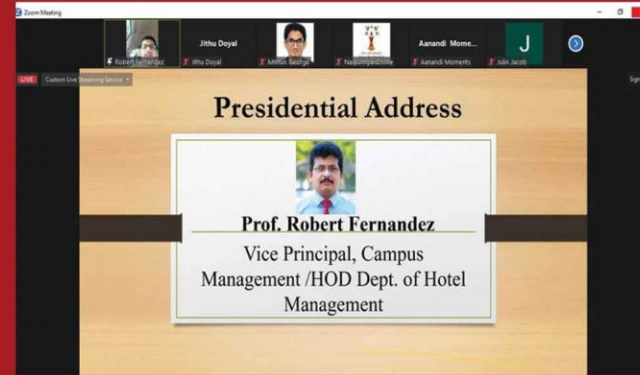
Faculty Exchange Programme

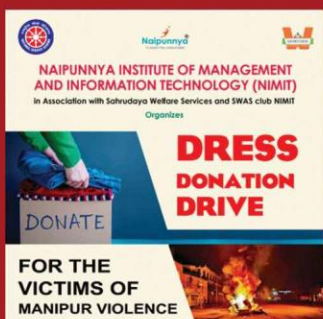
Bastille Day - French Movie Show

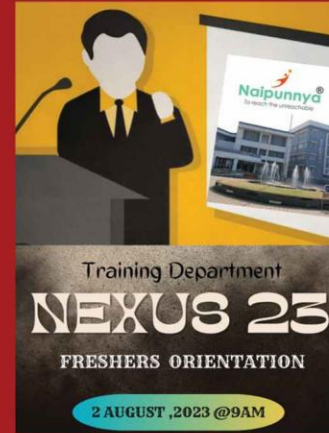


Gift Spot

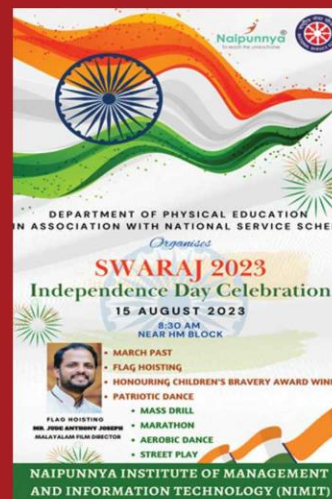
Nexus

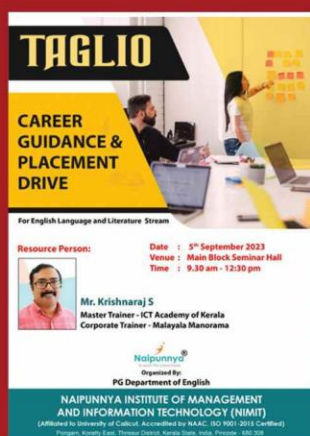


La Linguistique

Taglio - Career Guidance and Placement Drive

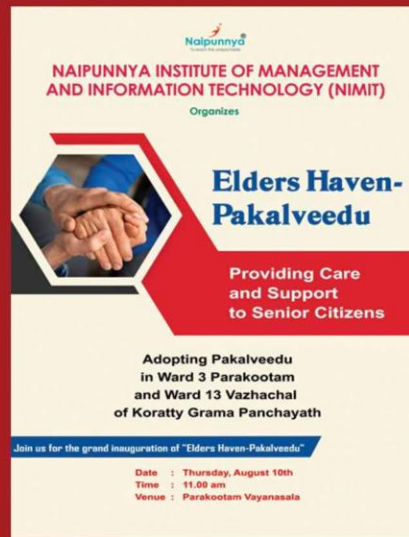

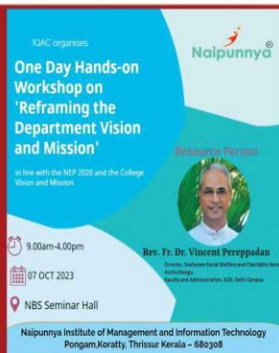
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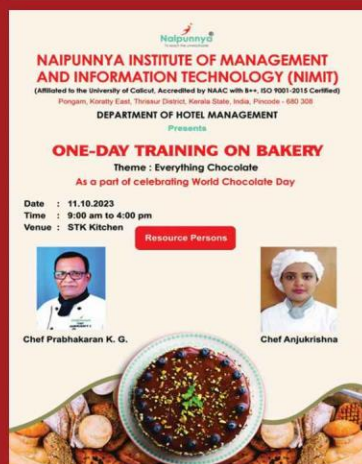
Workshop on Mission and Vision

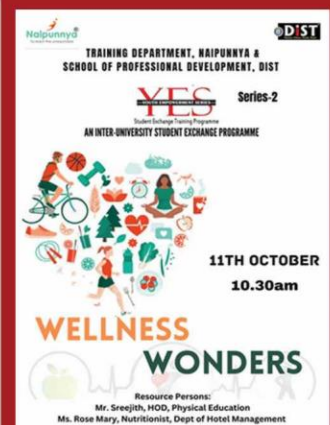
Workshop on Writing Long-Form Articles

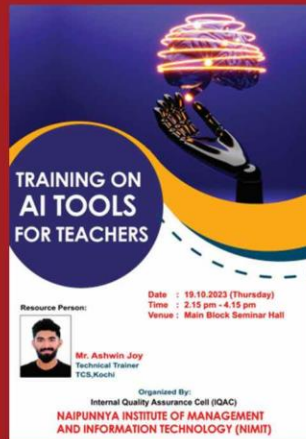
French Workshop

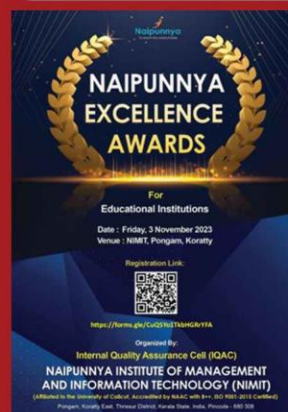
Tarang

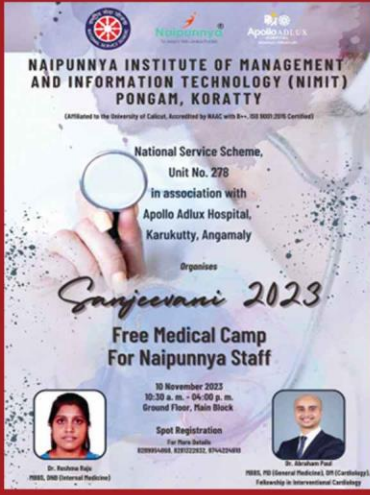
Chicken Tikka Challenge

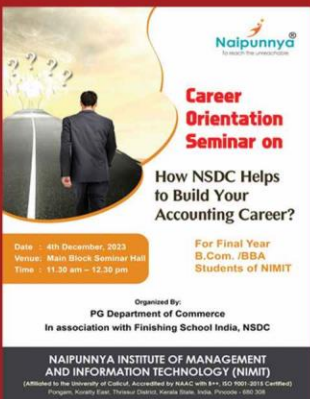
Laqshya 2023- Techno Cultural Management Fest

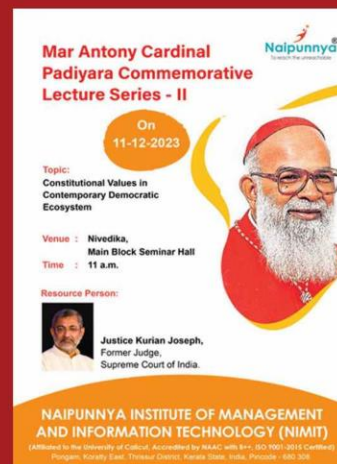


One Book One Naipunnya

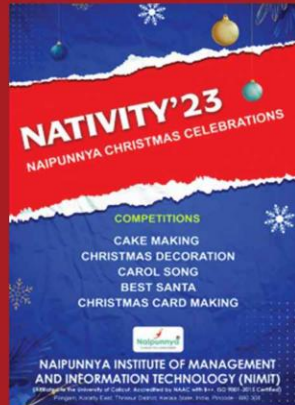
Mar Antony Cardinal Padiyara Commemorative Lecture Series

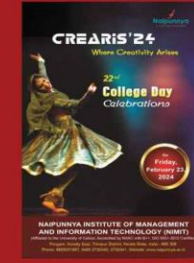
Aarohan

Takshak, the job fair for the final year students was held on 15th April on the campus. All the final years were expected to register for the job fair. Around 28 organizations conducted interviews for our students.



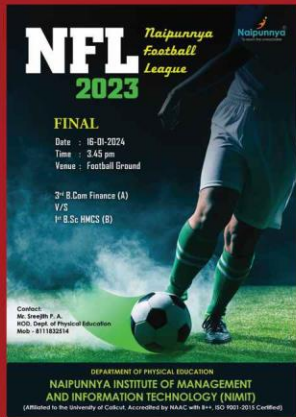
Leader's Thrive

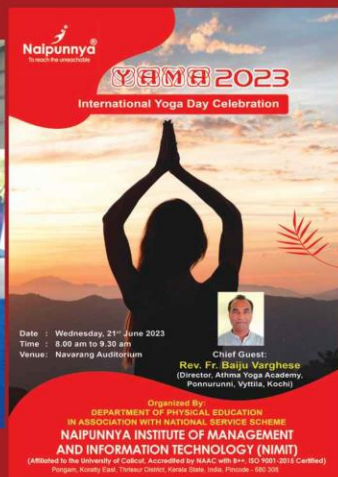
CORSA 2023
