Institution Profile

Naipunnya College, established in 1998 under the leadership of Rev. Fr. Sebastian Kalapurakal, has evolved from centre for vocational training to a centre for academic excellence. In collaboration with KITTS, Govt. of Kerala, we introduced a three-year diploma course in Hotel Management in 2000, marking a significant milestone. In 2002, Naipunnya Institute of Management and Information Technology (NIMIT) was inaugurated, affiliated with the University of Calicut. The expansion continued in 2012 with the establishment of Naipunnya Business School (NBS), approved by AICTE.

Accreditations and Certifications:

We are proud of the accreditations and certifications we have received, affirming the quality of education provided at NIMIT. ISO Certification 9001-2008 by AQA, upgraded to ISO 9001-2015 by TUY, demonstrates our commitment to maintaining the highest standards. NIMIT received NAAC accreditation with B++ in its first cycle in 2019, recognizing our academic excellence and infrastructure. This year, we are in the process of the second cycle of NAAC accreditation.

Snehasangamam- The event provided a meaningful opportunity to connect with individuals with special needs from 22 different institutions. The event emphasized the importance of inclusion and the joy of building connections across diverse communities. On the day of Snehasangamam, the NIMIT campus welcomed the inmates with open arms. Care and attention were given to every detail to ensure that the guests felt comfortable and valued. The second-year student coordinators took charge of organizing fun and engaging activities, providing personal interaction, and assisting with the inmates' needs throughout the day.

Rebuild Mission- As a part of the rebuild mission this year, we decided to support a student by undertaking a house construction project. This initiative was made possible through the generous contributions of our compassionate students, dedicated staff, alumni, benefactors and supportive management. By coming together and pooling our resources, we made a significant impact in fulfilling the dreams of at least one student. Our collective efforts not only provided them with a safe and secure home but also gave them a renewed sense of hope and stability. This project embodies the spirit of unity and compassion that our institution stands for. We firmly believe that everyone deserves a place to call home, and we are honoured to be able to make a difference in the life of this deserving student.

Elders' Haven-PAKALVEEDU- It is a noble community project initiated by our students support elderly individuals living alone in Ward 3 Parakootam and Ward 13 Vazhichal of Koratty Grama Panchayat by providing essential day-care services. Aimed at addressing loneliness among senior citizens, the project enhances cognitive stimulation through engaging activities, personalized care, physical exercise, and intergenerational connections. It also offers platforms for seniors to pursue hobbies and lifelong learning while maintaining their independence and health. For students, the project fosters empathy, communication skills, personal growth, leadership, volunteerism, and cultural awareness through meaningful interactions with the elderly.

Share a Meal- The 'Zero Hunger' initiative, launched under the Hand in Hand project for 2023-24, aims to eradicate hunger among NIMIT students by ensuring access to adequate, safe, and nutritious food. To address food insecurity and ensure no student attends college hungry, daily lunch packs are provided to those in need. The Department of Hotel Management prepared these balanced meals using sustainable, campus-sourced ingredients. The distribution process was conducted discreetly to maintain the dignity and privacy of the recipients, ensuring that their immediate food needs are met without compromising their self-respect.

Laptop Distribution Programme- To support digital learning, we launched a laptop scheme providing teachers and students with laptops, ensuring that all members of our academic community have the necessary tools for effective online education. The NIMIT Laptop

Sponsorship Programme, in association with the Jeevadan Center for Women, known as 'Grand Wallet' for students and 'Snehapoorvam' for staff members, aims to provide laptops at a reduced cost to enhance educational and professional experiences. This 10 lakh project distributed laptops to 50 stakeholders, promoting access to technology and facilitating academic and professional development.

Employability:

We are dedicated to ensuring that our students are well-prepared for their future careers. In the academic year 2023-2024, we organized numerous career guidance sessions for students across all undergraduate and postgraduate programs. These sessions provided valuable insights into various career paths and equipped students with the necessary skills to excel in their chosen arenas. Additionally, we facilitated both on-campus and off-campus recruitment opportunities to connect our students with potential employers.

Experiential Learning Activities:

We firmly believe in providing our students with practical and hands-on learning experiences. In the academic year 2023 - 2024 several experiential learning activities were organized, including: Management Fest, Class Fests, Resonance, Theme Dinner, Zenorix, Chutney Soca, Phoenix, Cazadorz. These activities not only enriched our students' academic knowledge but also fostered their leadership, teamwork, and organizational Skills. NIMIT marked a significant milestone on October 30th with the grand inauguration of its campus radio Taal 20.23. The radio promises to be a vibrant platform for students to express their creativity, share ideas, and engage the campus community through diverse programming.

Add-on Programmes

At Naipunnya College, we believe in offering our students opportunities to enhance their skills and broaden their knowledge beyond their core programmes. Around 40 add-on courses were provided to the students of different departments this year. These courses were designed to equip our students with additional skills and knowledge that are highly sought after in the professional world, ensuring their employability and giving them a competitive edge.

Sustainability Initiatives:

We are dedicated to providing sustainable practices and environmental awareness among our college community. In collaboration with the Kerala Agricultural Department and Koratty Gram Panchayat, we initiated an institutional organic farming project. In addition, we actively participated in paddy sowing and harvesting activities, further emphasizing our commitment to sustainability preserving traditional agricultural practices.

Pratidhi Center for Happiness and Wellbeing

Our college prioritizes the mental health and wellbeing of our students through the Pratidhi Center for Happiness and Wellbeing. Our team includes an on-campus Clinical Psychologist and student counselor, along with visiting professional psychologists who address mental health issues weekly.
