### **Moving to Autonomy**

### **Upgrading LMS to ERP**

We have upgraded our Learning Management System (LMS) to a comprehensive Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system. This upgrade integrates all facets of our operations, from academic management to financial and human resources, ensuring seamless information flow and operational efficiency. The institution purchased Linways version 4 for the same.

### **Providing New Add-On and Value-Added Programmes**

In our commitment to holistic education, we have introduced several new add-on and value-added programs. These programs are designed to equip students with additional skills and knowledge, enhancing their employability and readiness for diverse career paths.

### **Submission of Self-Study Report (SSR)**

The submission of the Self-Study Report (SSR) was a significant milestone. The SSR provides a detailed account of our institutional performance, strengths, and areas for improvement, forming the basis for accreditation and continuous quality enhancement. The SSR for the second cycle of NAAC Accreditation was submitted on 22 April 2024.

### **E-Governance and Government Aid Communication to Local Community**

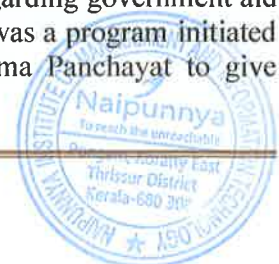
Our e-governance initiative aims to streamline administrative processes and improve transparency. Additionally, we have enhanced communication with the local community regarding government aid and services, ensuring that critical information is accessible to all. E-Assist was a program initiated by PG Department of Computer Science in association with Koratty Grama Panchayat to give awareness about New Computer Technologies' on 01 December 2023.

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### **Elders Haven - Pakalveedu: A Community Project**

'Elders Haven - Pakalveedu' is a community project dedicated to providing care and support to senior citizens. This initiative offers a safe and nurturing environment, enriching the lives of the elderly through various activities and healthcare services. This project was specifically dedicated to provide care and support to senior citizens. The inauguration was on **August 10, Thursday at 11.00 am in Parakootam Vayanasala**. A group of 10 students, each representing various departments, joined for the inauguration, and distributed Karkidaka Kanji kits to 100 senior citizens. Our college has selected Ward 3 Parakootam and Ward 13 Vazhachal of Koratty Panchayat for this noble cause. This initiative will be carried out as part of our outreach program for the year 2023-24.

### **Laptop Scheme for Teachers and Students**

To support digital learning, we have launched a laptop scheme providing teachers and students with laptops. This initiative ensures that all members of our academic community have the necessary tools to engage in effective online education. The NIMIT Laptop Sponsorship Programme in association with Jeevadan center for women, (also known as 'Grand Wallet' for students and 'Snehapoorvam' for staff members, aims to provide laptops to students and faculty at a reduced cost. The goal is to enhance their educational and professional experiences. The programme, a 10 lakh project aims to distribute laptops to 50 stakeholders. The objective was to promote access to technology, facilitate academic and professional development, and ensure that all participants have the necessary tools for effective learning and teaching.

### **Multidisciplinary International Conference**

We hosted a Multidisciplinary International Conference, providing a platform for scholars to present their research. It was conducted on 17 January 2024. Selected papers from the conference were published in a Web of Science Journal-Indian Journal of Natural Science, contributing to the global academic discourse.

### **Local Water Body Conservation**

As part of our commitment to environmental sustainability, we have undertaken a project to conserve local water bodies. This initiative involves cleaning, maintaining, and monitoring these water bodies to preserve the local ecosystem.
