This translates to an average generation capacity of 200 units per day, culminating in a remarkable annual yield of 72,000 units across the span of 12 months. Additionally, the college annually meets 2640 kilowatt-hours (KWH) of its power requirement through renewable sources (solar water heater) showcasing a commitment to clean energy.

**LED Lighting:** Approximately 76.17% of the annual lighting power requirements are met through the use of energy-efficient LED bulbs, contributing to energy conservation.

**Waste Management:** The college employs a comprehensive waste management system. Segregation at source is a priority, with organic waste, toxic waste, and recyclables all sorted. The institution follows the principles of Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle.
