Naipunnya Institute of Management and Information Technology organized a one-day seminar on the comprehensive exploration and strategic implementation of the new education policy in higher education institutes in association with IQAC. The seminar was held on November 11 from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. in Nivedika (the main block seminar hall) on the college campus. The seminar was about the New Education Policy (NEP) 2020, a comprehensive framework aimed at transforming the education system in India. This policy provides for a comprehensive, sustainable, and reformative roadmap for a paradigm shift in the entire education system of the country. It addresses the existing gaps and challenges and promotes the holistic development of students.

The seminar began at 9:30 a.m. with an invocation to God Almighty. Ms. Jeena Antony sang the prayer song, and Rev. Fr. Dr. Paulachan K. J., Executive Director and Principal, welcomed the gathering. Rev. Msgr. Antony Perumayan, Syncellus, Archdiocese of Ernakulam-Angamaly, gave the inaugural address. He explained the importance of NEP and why colleges have to be updated in certain areas. Dr. Shakila T. Shamsu delivered the keynote address. She spoke about the National Education Policy 2020, which heralds numerous reforms across the entire sector of education. Education is the key driver of growth and development. The NEP 2020 aims to transform India into a knowledge society with educated, skilled manpower of high standards, equipped to meet the challenges of the 21st century. The policy is based on the goals of access, equity, quality, affordability, and accountability. NEP 2020 brings out a wide range of comprehensive reforms that would transform the landscape of one of the world's largest and most complex educational systems. Both individual and institutional enablement are at its core. On July 29, 2023, it will be three years since the approval of NEP 2020. Since then, a number of actions have been done and are still being taken to put the NEP 2020 proposals into practice in higher education and the classroom. The discussion was quite educational.

The next session was by Dr. Shafeeque V, a research officer on special duty. He spoke about how the National Education Policy 2020 aims to bring about significant changes in the education system in India, emphasizing a more holistic and flexible approach to learning. It encourages a multidisciplinary approach, flexibility in choosing subjects, and a focus on skill development. Kerala, known for its progressive approach to education, is likely to incorporate these principles into its curriculum. Potential innovations in the U.G. curriculum in Kerala, in alignment with the NEP, could include:

Multidisciplinary Approach: Integration of various disciplines to provide students with a broader and more holistic understanding of subjects. **introduction of interdisciplinary courses and projects that encourage collaboration across different fields.** **Flexibility in Course Selection:** Allowing students greater flexibility in choosing their courses and creating personalized academic paths. **Providing options for**

students to select electives based on their interests and career goals. Focus on Critical Thinking and Problem Solving: Emphasis on developing critical thinking skills through interactive and problem-based learning methods, integration of real-world applications and case studies into the curriculum.


Skill Development: Inclusion of skill development courses to prepare students for the demands of the modern workforce by working with industry partners for internships, workshops, and hands-on experiences. **Technology Integration:** Leveraging technology for effective learning, including online resources, virtual labs, and digital assessments and integration of emerging technologies and digital tools relevant to each discipline.

Assessment Reforms: Implementation of continuous assessment methods to evaluate students' progress more comprehensively with focus on reducing the emphasis on rote memorization and promoting a more comprehensive understanding of concepts. **Inclusive Education:** Ensuring inclusivity in the curriculum to address the diverse needs of students by incorporating content that reflects a variety of perspectives and experiences.

Prof. Dr. Gabriel Simon Thattil, HoD, Department of Commerce, University of Kerala, led the following session. The topic for this session was "NEP 2020: Reforms in HEI. The National Education Policy 2020 for higher education aims to transform the existing higher education system in India. This policy emphasizes promoting interdisciplinary studies, introducing new subjects, providing flexibility in courses, and providing fresh opportunities to students. It aims to increase the Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) in higher education, provide multiple entry and exit options, and allows students to choose courses according to their interests and aptitude.

The policy envisions the establishment of a national research foundation, a national education technology forum, and higher education institutions in the country. The policy is aimed at creating a holistic and flexible education system that is adaptive to the needs of the 21st century. The session was interactive, and the day was fruitful. All the participants were filled with a new zeal to start working on its implementation in their own spheres. The program concluded with a vote of thanks by Mr. Sebastian Poonolly, and feedback was taken from the faculties. Certificates were distributed to all who registered for the seminar. The official program concluded by 4:00 p.m.

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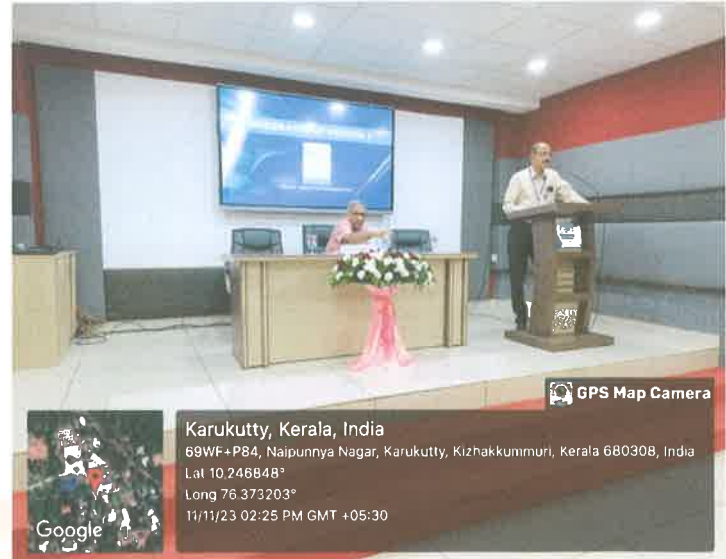

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
